GOALS FOR LIFE TO HOLD MUSIC FUNDRAISER MAY 7 TO BENEFIT "IN THE PINK" BREAST CANCER PROGRAMS

Goals for Life, the Montclair-based non-profit organization, will hold a Coffeehouse on Friday, May 7 from 8 to 11 p.m. at the First Congregational Church in Montclair to benefit "In The Pink," the breast cancer education and outreach program run by St. Michael's Medical Center in Newark.

The Goals for Life Coffeehouse will feature folk, rock and alternative music provided by area musicians. Tickets, available at the door, are \$7 for adults and \$5 for students with identification. First Congregational Church is located at 40 South Fullerton Avenue next to the Montclair Library.

Goals for Life, established in 2000, raises money for women's health initiatives. In the past four years, it has donated nearly \$70,000 to the New Jersey Chapter of the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation; the domestic violence programs run by the Montclair Health Department; and "In The Pink." This year, all Goals for Life fund raising activities will benefit "In The Pink." The Fourth Annual Goals for Life Women's Charity Soccer Tournament is on Saturday, June 7 in Brookdale Park.
